<u>Student/Parent Handbook</u>: Please read the student/parent handbook at the front of your child's agenda.

Agenda: The agenda will be used as an organization tool for your child. Since assignments and tests are written in your child's agenda throughout the week, we are asking parents to <u>check</u> the agenda <u>daily</u>. Students will be responsible for bringing their agendas to and from school each day. Loading backpacks at night before bed will help ensure nothing is forgotten at home or in the car. It is also the student's responsibility to make sure any notes from home are given to the teacher.

<u>Graded</u> Papers: Graded paper work will be sent home with the progress reports. We are asking parents to review these papers with their child then sign and return them to school the next day.

Daily Folder: Each student's Daily Folder will contain: study guides, unfinished class work (homework) and completed work ready to turn in. Each student needs to take their Daily Folder home **every night**. This gives parents the opportunity to review assignments and discuss concepts we are working on in class.

Conduct: Please encourage good conduct. Distractions and interruptions caused by misbehavior reduce precious instruction time. Good behavior benefits everyone. Repetitive misbehavior will result in parent conferences and office referrals.

Donations: The fourth grade is requesting a \$25 donation. Your donation goes towards essential classroom supplies. It is both needed and appreciated. This money comes back to you in a way that helps educate your child.

Lunchroom: Our lunch time is from <u>11:50-12:20</u>. Parents are welcome to eat with their child whenever possible; however, please notify the school 24 hours in advance of your visit so that we may let the lunchroom know how many lunches to prepare.
